

FRONT BEADED SINGLE CROCHET STITCH INSTRUCTIONS

1. Push the bead down close to your work.



2. Hold on to the bead with your thumb, insert hook in the indicated stitch going underneath (behind) the bead.



3. Keep holding the bead, yarn over and pull through the two loops on hook, working a sc.



4. Front Beaded Single crochet stitch complete and the bead should now be on the front of your work.



Notes:

- * Keep thread tension a little tight to force the bead to stay in place.
- * Be sure to hold the bead in place with your thumb while completing the sc stitch.
- * This stitch is sometimes called Beaded Single Crochet or BSC.
- * Abbreviation: FBSC
